In addition, there are numerous state-specific requirements that apply to Truckers or Motor Carrier applications. ACORD 132 cannot address these various unique specifications. Therefore, state specific forms, ACORD 137, have been developed to respond to these requirements. See the State Forms FIG for more information.</p> <p>This form was designed to be used in conjunction with ACORD 125, Commercial Insurance Application - Applicant Information Section and ACORD 129, Vehicle Schedule. In some cases, the applicant must be allowed to select among various options.
