<b>Section Name</b>	<b>Field Name</b>	<b>Field and/or Section Description</b>
<b>TITLE ACORD 405 (2007/09)</b>	<b>Agriculture Premises / Location Diagram</b>	The title of the form. ACORD 405, Agriculture Premises / Location Diagram, is used as an attachment to ACORD 401, the basic agriculture insurance application to provide a diagram of the premises to be insured.  Use a separate form for each premises.
<b>IDENTIFICATION SECTION</b>	<b>Agency Customer ID</b>	Enter identifier: The customer's identification number assigned by the producer (e.g. agency or brokerage).
<b>IDENTIFICATION SECTION</b>	<b>Date</b>	Enter date: The month/day/year on which the form is completed. (MM/DD/YYYY)
<b>IDENTIFICATION SECTION</b>	<b>Agency</b>	Enter text: The full name of the producer/agency.
<b>IDENTIFICATION SECTION</b>	<b>Applicant/First Named Insured</b>	Enter text: The named insured(s) as it/they will appear on the policy declarations page.
<b>IDENTIFICATION SECTION</b>	<b>Policy Number</b>	Enter identifier: The identifier assigned by the insurer to the policy, or submission, being referenced exactly as it appears on the policy, including prefix and suffix symbols. If required for self-insurance, the self-insured license or contract number.
<b>IDENTIFICATION SECTION</b>	<b>Carrier</b>	Enter text: The insurer's full legal company name(s) as found in the file copy of the policy. Use the actual name of the company within the group to which the policy has been issued. This is not the insurer's group name or trade name.
<b>IDENTIFICATION SECTION</b>	<b>NAIC Code</b>	Enter code: The identification code assigned to the insurer by the NAIC.
<b>IDENTIFICATION SECTION</b>	<b>Account Number</b>	Enter identifier: The account number to be used for billing purposes. This is the billing number assigned by the billing entity. If agency bill, the agency assigns; if direct bill, the insurer assigns. If the account already exists, the agent should provide the previously assigned number.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>	<b>Diagram #</b>	Enter identifier: The producer assigned identifier for the diagram of the location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>	<b>Location #</b>	Enter number: The producer assigned number of the location. As used here, enter the location number from the ACORD 401.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>	<b>Phone Number</b>	Enter number: The primary phone number of the location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>	<b>Premises Address</b>	Enter text: The first address line of the physical location. As used here, enter the address from the ACORD 401.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter text: The second address line of the physical location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter text: The third address line of the physical location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter text: The city of the physical location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter code: The state or province of the physical location.

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<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter code: The postal code of the physical location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter text: The section of the insured location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter text: The township of the insured location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter text: The range of the insured location.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>		Enter text: The longitude of the insured location. This is the arc or portion of the earth's equator intersected between the meridian of a given place and the prime meridian and expressed in degrees. The format of the data follows The International Organization for Standardization 6709 and is sent as +/-XXX.YYYYYYYYY. The GPS longitude coordinate.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>	<b>Premises Address</b>	Enter text: The latitude of the insured location. This is the angular distance north or south from the earth's equator measured through 90 degrees. The format of the data follows The International Organization for Standardization 6709 and is sent as +/-XX.YYYYYYYYY. The GPS latitude coordinate.
<b>PREMISES INFORMATION</b>	<b>Notes</b>	Enter text: The directions on how to locate the property including nearest cross streets.
<b>Edition</b>	<b>Date</b>	The edition identifier of the form including the form number and edition (the date is typically formatted YYYY/MM).
